



Every year Raleigh-Wake sponsors a Mentor Program for our local student chapters; NCSU, Peace College and Meredith College. Students are paired with local HR professionals in all areas of expertise based on the student's areas of interest. The program will begin on **Wednesday, November 11th at 6 pm** at Meredith College in the Alumnae Building.

Are you familiar with how "speed dating" works? This year a new pairing process will be trialled. Students will rotate amongst the professionals and spend just two minutes with each, at the end of the allotted time both professional and students will sign up for their top three mentor/mentee pairings based on their professional interests during the round. Each participant will receive a follow-up e-mail to complete the process and then the mentor relationship will do the rest.

Some of the program's former activities included: job shadowing, career counseling, hosting the student at a RWHHRMA chapter meeting, role playing a mock-interview, resume critiques, or workplace tour. Due to the success of the program, every year we need more volunteers to mentor. This year our goal is 20 mentors, so if you are looking for a way to get involved with the chapter but have limited time available, this program could be for you.
